TRANSIT

Swan Island is one of the best served industrial employment areas of the region.

TriMet 85 Swan Island operates weekdays from 5:42am to 5:40pm from the Rose Quarter Transit Center, with connections to the MAX Yellow line at Albina/Mississippi.

TriMet 72 Killingsworth/82nd Avenue provides Frequent Service seven days/week from before 6am until after Midnight from Clackamas Town Center to Anchor Street on Swan Island, with peak hour service to the Shipyards ("Drydock").

Swan Island Evening Shuttle operates weekdays from 6:36pm to 11:36pm from the Rose Quarter Transit Center, with "By Request" service to Mock's Bottom and the Shipyards. Call 503-757-7152 for pick up.

C-Tran operates "Limited" bus service from Clark county to the Interstate MAX Yellow Line and the Airport MAX Red Line; All zone fares are good for both C-Tran and TriMet buses and MAX.

Employer subsidies: many Swan Island employers offer partial or full transit pass subsidies; check with your HR department or have your employer contact TriMet Employer Programs, 503-962-7670 or employerprograms@trimet.org. You may be able to purchase your pass with pretax dollars.

Getting to Swan Island by transit will take less time than you think!



EMERGENCY RIDE HOME

At work without your car? Sick Child? Family Emergency? Emergency Ride Home has got you covered. Eligible employees must have used alternative means of transportation to get to work: carpool, vanpool, bus and/or MAX, walking, bicycling or other alternatives pre-approved by TriMet. **Contact your Transportation Coordinator or the Swan Island TMA for more information.**



BIKE/WALK

Dozens of Swan Island employees ride bicycles to work, many all year.

Portland's network of trails, bike lanes and bike ways make it easy to get to Swan Island via 'Going to the River,' the Going Street multiuse path. Most bike commuters use the sidewalk once on the Island.

RIDESHARE

Carpools are the most popular alternative to driving alone for Swan Island employees.

Find a carpool partner at www.carpoolmatchnw.org (all personal information, such as home address, is confidential) or put a note up in your break room. Sharing the ride to work with just one other person cuts your commute costs in half and, for Clark county commuters, puts you in the HOV lane on I-5 northbound!
